Please note that all nominations must be lodged via the online E-Awards portal by **Friday 21 May, 2010**. Submissions will not be accepted unless you have nominated by this date.

If you do not notify our office before this date, there will be no refund on your nomination fee. Refunds will not be given after the closing date for entries, **Friday 20 August 2010**.

Submissions and images must be received by **5pm Friday 20 August, 2010**. Entries received after this date **WILL NOT** be accepted.
